Dear Graduating Senior,

The Black Gold Stampede Rodeo, Rusk County Rodeo Association, is offering scholarship opportunities for qualified graduating seniors in Rusk County. Each \$4000 scholarship will be distributed at \$500.00 for each consecutive fall and spring semester. To maintain eligibility, the recipient must maintain RCRA grade and enrollment requirements and adhere to all deadlines stated herein. Failure to meet any of the listed requirements during any semester nullifies any remaining amount of the scholarship stipend. The number of scholarships awarded will be decided by the RCRA Scholarship Committee each year.

Recipients must show official proof of the required enrollment by **September 1, 2026**, to RCRA Treasurer to receive the first \$500.00 installment. For all additional installments, recipients must show successful completion of a minimum of twelve (12) academic semester hours each semester, with a minimum grade point average of 2.5, and provide official proof of required enrollment for the following semesters for the remaining three years (fall and spring) to be eligible to receive the remaining \$500.00 installments of the stipend. Official proof of enrollment, course completion and GPA must be turned in to RCRA by the September 1st/February 1st following the semester. Failure to comply with any of the above stated terms nullifies any remaining balance of the scholarship stipend.

Please read through the application form before beginning. Completion of the application form may require some information from your parents, guardians and counselor. All other answers should be your own thoughts, in your own words. Answer all questions completely and thoroughly as possible.
